

CHESTER FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

October & November 2022

I will be presenting information in this report on activities that were from the month prior. Following this process ensures that time and thought has gone into this report, so it is complete and informational.

Synopsis:

October 4th was my first day with the department. During the month of October, I held an all-hands meeting to make introductions and present my management style. I had an in-depth tour of the department facilities and apparatus. I met with neighboring fire chiefs, attend several EMS, radio communications and training meetings throughout the county and attended the high school bonfire event for homecoming. November was spent working on staffing and planning for future operations.

California Fire Assistance Agreement (Incident Management Support)

Another big project we are working on is creating systems to manage our Support Division personnel. I will have more information on this in the near future, we have meetings this month to plan operations for this program.

Personnel / Human Resources

Firefighter/Engineer Paramedic Matt Turner resigned his position with the department on 10/11/22. He had worked here for approximately 18 1/2 years full-time and served as volunteer for 3 years prior to that.

Probationary Firefighter Kyle Araiza resigned his position as a Probationary Firefighter on 11/17/22. He has gone back to work on the ambulance in Butte County. He was with us for almost a year.

Firefighter/Engineer EMT Dave Carr completed his first year of service with the department on 11/21/22 and is now officially off of probation.

I updated and issued a job announcement for Per Diem Firefighter/Paramedic and Firefighter/EMT in early October in an effort to have a pool of as needed employees to hire when full-time personnel are unavailable. I pushed the announcement to the following agencies to recruit and received zero applications:

Following the last Board meeting, on 10/24/22, I immediately issued the job announcement for Reserve Firefighter I and II to recruit out of area volunteers to train with our agency. We haven't received any applications yet, but the semester doesn't end for a few more weeks. We are hopeful that as students graduate from the fire academy they will apply with us to gain training and experience.

On 11/28/22 the decision was made to temporarily increase the hourly salary for EMT to \$25.00 and for Paramedic to \$45.00. This was done to attract Per Diem, as needed, staff to cover shifts and help reduce the forced overtime being created by vacancies. We are getting applicants now and they are being interviewed and will soon be onboarded. I will have additional information in my report at the meeting.

OPERATIONS

Community Involvement / Public Relations

Our crew participated with the truck in the High School parade and bon fire for homecoming. The day before the football game we were able to assist in using our aerial truck's ladder to change out light bulbs along the football field. On Halloween our Firefighters were out on Main Street handing out candy with our other public safety partners.

Apparatus / Equipment

A mobile mechanic came up from the bay area to provide me a complete inspection on our apparatus. Our personnel provided a list of small issues that were easily repaired over his two-day visit. He will be back in a few weeks to work on the ambulance, 7252, which is having mechanical issues. While the mobile mechanic was here, he described the work that would be required to make our type III engine serviceable. We've decided that it does not make financial sense to make the needed repairs so we are currently in the process of declaring the engine as surplus so we can sell it. This will be coming to you in the near future as an action item.

Turnouts are being cleaned and inventoried by Firefighter/Engineer Johnson. He has also documented all serial numbers in our data management system so we can digitally assign our gear to personnel. This process will help track when equipment is due for inspection and the date that it's scheduled for retirement. Additionally, as we hire new personnel, we will have immediate access to determine if we have their sizes in stock.

We received new "MSA" Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) which were purchased with grant funds. Firefighter/Engineer Johnson has added asset tags for
